What is the Red Team?

Red Team is composed of volunteers that have a technical background in IT or OT and will play the role of "hackers". They will be penetration testing, running plays, and actively working to breach the systems of the collegiate Blue Teams. Our Red Team must pass a short CTF to compete in the formal Red Team.

What is the CyberForce Competition[®]?

The CyberForce Competition is a collegiate cybersecurity competition by the Department of Energy for workforce development. The purpose of this competition is to help the students (Blue Teams) develop and enhance their skills by defending against "hackers" (Red Team volunteers) in realistic energy-based scenarios.
